

## **SCAIHS Student Ranking**

In compliance with the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education, class rankings are determined by all completed coursework submitted or postmarked by June 7. Rank is based on students' GPA using the South Carolina Uniform Grading Scale (weighted). Because of eligibility requirements for state scholarships set by the Commission on Higher Education, all SCAIHS College Prep and Career/Technical track students (those meeting the basic diploma requirements by SC standards) must be ranked for any of them to qualify. The SC CHE ranking deadline is June 15th.

## **Reporting Deadlines & Class Rank**

SCAIHS has chosen to participate in class ranking for our students in the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> grade years. We do this to afford our students the opportunity to pursue state-sponsored scholarships for college (LIFE, Palmetto Fellows, etc.). As part of the SC Commission on Higher Education policy to be eligible for state scholarships, we must rank ALL students meeting diploma requirements by SC standards (CP and Career/Technical tracks), and we must complete it by the CHE assigned deadline of June 15th.

- Our academic year is June 1 – May 31, and High School Year-End Records are due no later than June 7. These reports need to include the SCAIHS reports as well as grade reports from any outside classes taken.
- GPA and class ranking are determined by all completed coursework submitted or postmarked by June 7.
- If a course is not completed by May 31, the report card should be submitted *no later than June 7*, with an “INC” noting the incomplete course.
- **Credit for courses completed after May 31 will be included in the following attendance year. Please note that a maximum number of credits earned per year cannot exceed ten.**
- **\*\*\*Important- the deadline for Senior reports is May 15 in order to have records processed before graduation.**
